INSTRUCTIONS TO COMPETITORS:

1. The moot problem for the first round will appear on Lawborepro (>Careers>Mooting). I will leave a few hard copies in an envelope attached to the door of room 2/17 GIP (***Smith and Executors of the Estate of Beswick v Slow & Bideawhile***).
2. "Team" A will be arguing FOR Mr and Mrs Smith.
3. "Team" B will be arguing AGAINST Mr and Mrs Smith.
4. Leading Counsel on each team to consider whether "*a duty is owed to Mr and Mrs Smith.*"
5. Junior Counsel on each team to consider whether "*the damages fall within Hadley and Baxendale.*"
6. The highest scoring competitor from each moot will progress to round 2.
7. The names of the judges have yet to be confirmed, but will follow in due course.
8. The exact dates of round one are yet to be confirmed, but will be in weeks 20 and/or 21. **I would advise you to proceed on the basis that your moot could take place on Monday 7th February and to ensure that you have complied with the rules regarding service of skeleton arguments and preparation of the judge's bundle by close of play on Friday 4th February (see paragraphs 25-31 of the Mooting Rules).**
9. The moots can take place at any time during the day or evening and should be arranged to suit the convenience of judges and competitors (where possible, competitors have been placed in moots with others from the same cohort, in an attempt to make the fixing of dates easier). When judges are allocated to moots, the competitors in each moot must liaise with one another and the relevant judge to arrange a suitable date/time. Once I am notified of the decision I will organise a room (I can assist where necessary in the fixing of dates).
10. Each competitor will need the contact details of the other competitors in their moot. These can be accessed via the e-mail contacts list. However, if you encounter any difficulty please contact me and I will provide the necessary details. If you are happy for other competitors to have your mobile telephone number, please include it on your skeleton argument.
11. **PLEASE BE AWARE OF THE LIST OF RESERVES AND REMIND YOURSELVES OF THE RULES REGARDING WITHDRAWAL FROM THE COMPETITION (RULES 9 AND 40-42). ALL OF THE RESERVES HAVE CONFIRMED THAT THEY WOULD LIKE TO COMPETE IF AT ALL POSSIBLE.**
